### Overview >>>

Ohio is breaking ground with the addition of four new casinos throughout the state. The potential impact of casino gambling, and treatment services are an increasing topic of interest for ODADAS and our providers. We are pleased to offer two Stage I trainings at no cost. During the two-day training, participants will learn useful strategies that your organizations can use to improve outcomes, as well as provide strategies that will assist you in offering high quality, culturally-competent services to your consumers. You are encouraged to seize this wonderful opportunity to learn about accessing, treatment and recovery support for the problem gambler.

#### **Description** >>>

TREATING THE PATHOLOGICAL GAMBLER - STAGE I has been developed to increase your knowledge and understanding of the disease and prepare the practicing clinician to work with problem, pathological gamblers and their families. This training will include hands-on experiences and exercises.

- Day one will be a basic introduction to problem gambling as an addiction. We will provide an historical overview of gambling; the games and the addiction. We will also examine federal and state regulations surrounding gambling and the potential impact of changed legislation in Ohio.
- Day two will build on day one with an emphasis on treatment. The training will review evidence based practices in treating the addiction. You will be provided with tools and resources to treat the addiction.
